**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BREA,
CALIFORNIA ORDERING THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED
ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF A MEASURE CONCERNING
WHETHER CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 2009-64 WHICH
ADOPTED STREET SWEEPING PARKING RESTRICTIONS,
SHALL BE REPEALED, AT THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL
ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2010**

WHEREAS, the next regularly scheduled municipal election for the City of Brea shall be consolidated with the statewide general election to be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2010; and

WHEREAS, The City Council desires to submit to the voters at that election a question relating to whether City Council Resolution No. 2009-64, pertaining to street sweeping parking restrictions, shall be repealed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BREA HEREBY
RESOLVES AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The City Council, pursuant to its right and authority, hereby orders submitted to the voters at the November 2, 2010, General Municipal Election the following question:

Shall a resolution be adopted which repeals Brea City Council Resolution No. 2009-64, which enacted street sweeping parking restrictions?	YES
	NO

2. The proposed complete text of the measure to be submitted to the voters is the resolution attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

3. The ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

4. This Resolution authorizes, instructs and directs the City Clerk to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

5. The polls for the election shall open at 7:00 a.m. on November 2, 2010 and remain open continuously from that time until 8:00 p.m. on the same day when the polls shall close, except as provided in California Elections Code Section 14401.

6. In all particulars not recited in this Resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

7. This Resolution gives notice of the time and place of holding the election and authorizes, instructs and directs the City Clerk to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

8. The City Council authorizes the City Clerk to administer said election and the City shall pay all reasonable and actual election expenses upon presentation of a properly submitted bill.

9. The City Council authorized the City Clerk to administer said election and the City shall pay all reasonable and actual election expenses upon presentation of a properly submitted bill.

10. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
